Greenville Society for Human Resource Management Named Finalist for SHRM Pinnacle Award

Greenville, SC — Recently, SHRM (the Society for Human Resource Management) announced Greenville SHRM as a finalist for the 2020 Pinnacle Award in recognition of its high achievements advancing the profession of human resources.

The Pinnacle Award is the most prestigious honor SHRM state councils and chapters can receive. Created in 1991, the award honors programs that exceed the standard activities of SHRM affiliates in enhancing HR management. GSHRM joins 26 other SHRM councils and chapters in this recognition, along with the South Carolina SHRM State Council, who was also a finalist.

“The members of SHRM's chapters and state councils are essential in elevating the voice of HR and improving the workplaces of today, tomorrow, and the future. Quite simply, we wouldn't be where we are today without them,” said SHRM President and CEO, Johnny C. Taylor, Jr., SHRM-SCP. “Even amid a time of tremendous challenge and uncertainty, our finalists continued to unite and lead HR professionals through some of the toughest challenges of their careers, all while fostering a culture of growth and development.”

In 2020, GSHRM was recognized for their efforts in Veterans Inclusion. The organization was also a 2013 finalist for their work with membership outreach. GSHRM won the Pinnacle Award in in 2018 for their efforts in Disability Awareness and Inclusion, and in 2009 for Impacting Unemployment.

“This year’s recognition as a finalist for The Pinnacle Award is a welcome announcement, and we are honored to be among such great company in the list of other finalists,” said Leanne Fuller, Board President of GSHRM. “It is wonderful to know that our chapter here in Greenville not only puts in the work necessary to lead change and growth in the area of Human Resources, but that someone else has noticed it, as well.”
